OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHURCHILL & SARSDEN PARISHES) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20**

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order - in support of road safety issues - is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** throughout Churchill & Sarsden, replacing the majority of the existing 30mph speed limit in the process - leading outwards to the following points:

A. Churchill:

- 1. <u>B4450 Chipping Norton Road</u> a point 250 metres northeast of its junction with Hastings Hill,
- 2. <u>B4450 Junction Road</u> a point 25 metres southwest of its junction with William Smith Close,
- 3. Churchill Road a point 55 metres west of its junction with Sidings Road,
- 4. Hastings Hill a point 175 metres northwest of its junction with Sidings Road,
- 5. <u>Sarsden Road</u> a point 125 metres southeast of its junction with the B4450 Church Road/Junction Road.

B. Sarsden:

- 1. <u>Unnamed road running through Sarsden (north-western arm)</u> a point 90 metres southeast of its junction with Sarsden Road,
- <u>Unnamed road running through Sarsden (north-eastern arm)</u> a point 179 metres southwest of its junction with Sarsden Road,
- 3. <u>Unnamed road running through Sarsden (south-western arm)</u> a point 20 metres southwest of its junction with the access to Sarsden House,

Additionally, 20mph speed limits will be introduced on the following extents of road:

- 4. <u>Merriscourt Lane</u> from its junction with the Unnamed road running through Sarsden, south-eastwards for a distance of 15 metres,
- 5. <u>Unnamed road running through Sarsden</u> from a point 30 metres southwest of its junction with Merriscourt Lane, north-eastwards for a distance of 340 metres.

A section of existing 30mph speed limit will remain on the unnamed road running northeast / southwest through Sarsden, between the main residential area & its junction with Merriscourt Lane, with Officers having taken the current road environment & traffic usage into account.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Sarsden Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2009 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
