## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHURCHILL & SARSDEN PARISHES) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\*

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part III of schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Churchill & Sarsden Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 202\* and shall come into force on the .............. 202\*.
- 2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4.. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 5. The Oxfordshire County Council (Sarsden Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2009 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.

## SCHEDULE 1

#### 20mph Speed Limit:

#### **CHURCHILL**

The whole length of every road (excluding those not designated as Public Highway, or those lengths of road listed in schedules 2) in the village of Churchill extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	B4450 Chipping Norton Road	a point 250 metres northeast of its junction with Hastings Hill
b)	B4450 Junction Road	a point 25 metres southwest of its junction with William Smith Close

c)	Churchill Road	a point 55 metres west of its junction with Sidings Road
d)	Hastings Hill	a point 175 metres northwest of its junction with Sidings Road
e)	Sarsden Road	a point 125 metres southeast of its junction with the B4450 Church Road/Junction Road

#### SARSDEN

Roads in Sarsden subject to 30 mph speed limit:

#### **PART A**

The whole length of every road (excluding those not designated as Public Highway, or those lengths of road listed in schedules 2) in the village of Sarsden extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	unclassified road leading out of the village Unnamed road running through Sarsden (north- western arm)	a point 90 metres southeast of its junction with the A361 to Churchill road Sarsden Road.
b)	unclassified road leading out of the village Unnamed road running through Sarsden (north- eastern arm)	a point 179 metres southwest of its junction with the <del>A361 to Churchill road</del> Sarsden Road.
c)	unclassified road leading out of the village Unnamed road running through Sarsden (south western arm)	a point 30 20 metres southwest of its junction with Merriscourt Lane the access to Sarsden House

#### PART B

a)	Unnamed road running through Sarsden	from a point 30 metres southwest of its junction with Merriscourt Lane, northeastwards	for a distance of 340 metres.
b)	Merriscourt Lane	from its junction with the Unnamed road running through Sarsden, south- eastwards	for a distance of 15 metres,
